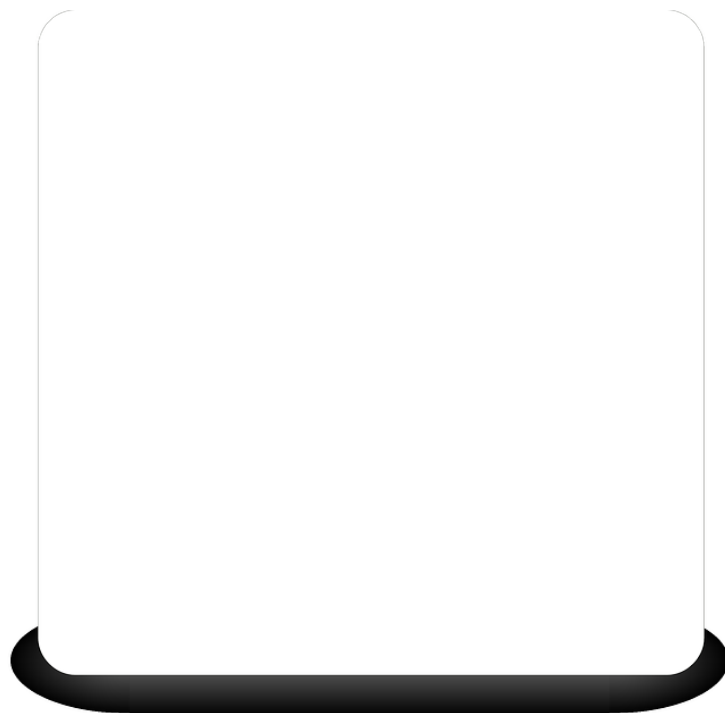


Japan's Otsuka expands in Australia

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Singapore: Japan's firm, Otsuka Pharmaceutical, has established a direct presence in Sydney, Australia, to bring innovative new medicines to patients in the country.
